### **Please keep these points in mind when preparing your presentations:**

- All communication will be with the Primary Presenter only. It is the Primary Presenter's responsibility to keep any co-presenters informed. If you received this e-mail you are considered the Primary Presenter.
- ***All presenters and co-presenters attending one full day or both full days of the convention are required to pay the full convention rate unless arrangements have been made with Arizona Health and Physical Education.***
- If you and any co-presenters are only attending for the day of your presentation, you will not need to pay a registration fee but you are expected to register yourself and any co-presenters on-line in order to be provided with a one-day pass/badge to the Convention. To do this, select the payment option "Presenter" and a one-day pass/badge for the day of your presentation will be provided.
- **All A/V equipment - such as computers, LCD projectors, internet connections, projector connection specific to your computer- are the responsibility of the Primary Presenter and will need to be made directly with the audio visual company we select or is responsible to bring any equipment needed.**
- All presentation rooms will be set in perimeter or lecture style (table and chairs) with theater seating in the back, a podium, microphone and head table at the front of the room.

## Parking

- Loading and unloading must take place on the street level or in the parking garages unless you have a large amount to unload. Street level unloading areas are located on the West side of the Phoenix Convention Center West Building. Vendors and presenters that are unloading on Tuesday, November 14th, please contact Matt Mixer ([mixer@azhpe.org](mailto:mixer@azhpe.org)) for instructions on how to get to the Convention Center loading docks.
- If you are staying in the downtown area: Please check with your hotel for daily and overnight parking information.
- Day of Convention Parking:
  - All parking garages around the convention center charge a fee of \$12 per day with the exception of the Jefferson Street Garage, located at 333 E Jefferson St, Phoenix, AZ 85004. Let them know you are attending the 2017 Arizona Health and Physical Education State Convention and they will charge a fee of \$5 per day. **No overnight privileges.**
